## 2022-2023 Survey Results

The UC Basic Needs Research & Evaluation team administered an online survey to all students who accessed Basic Needs services during Fall 2022, at nine participating University of California campuses. Through the survey, students provided feedback on the Basic Needs services offered on their campus, as well information about their housing status, food security, financial security and mental health. The following is an infographic report of the overall results.

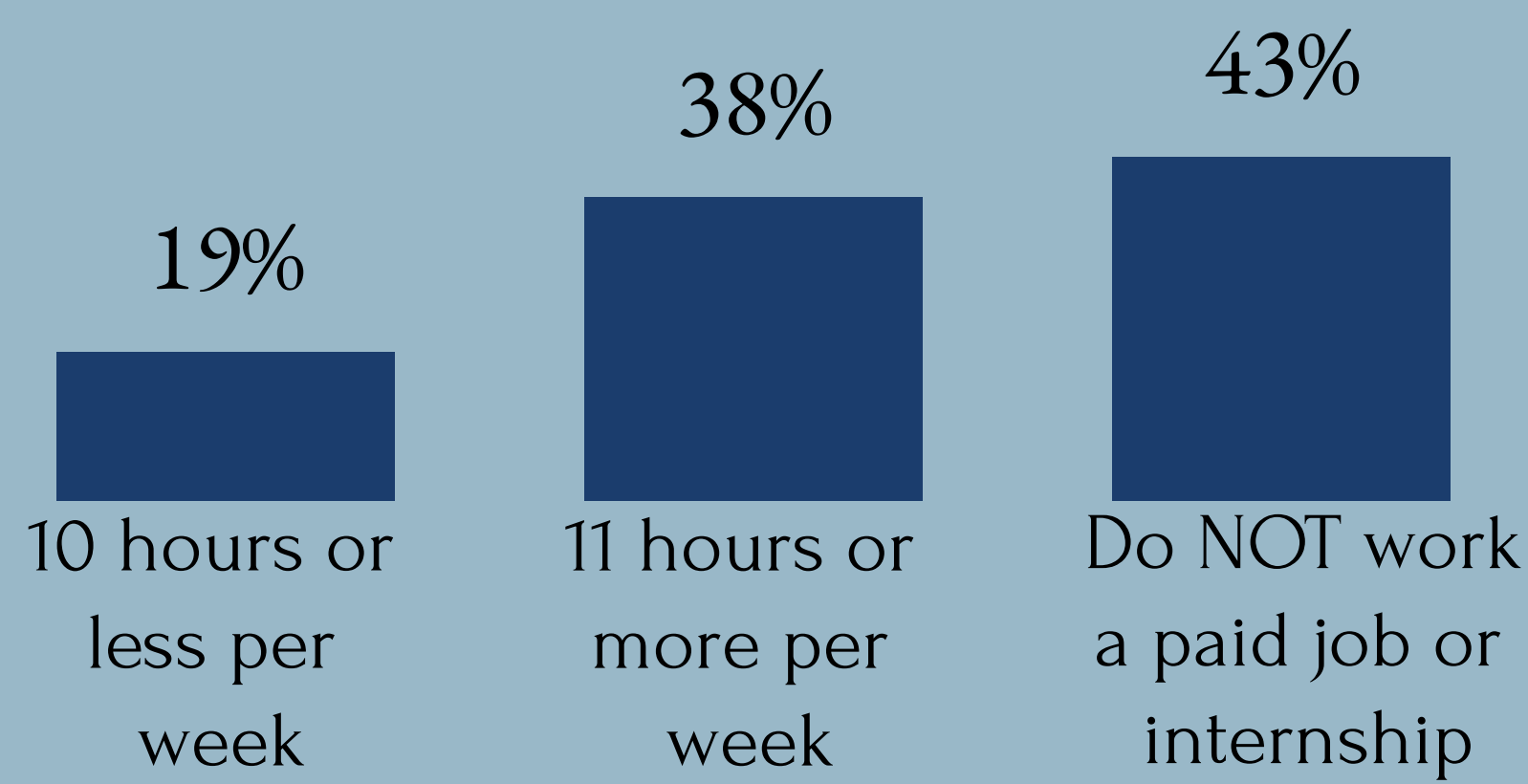

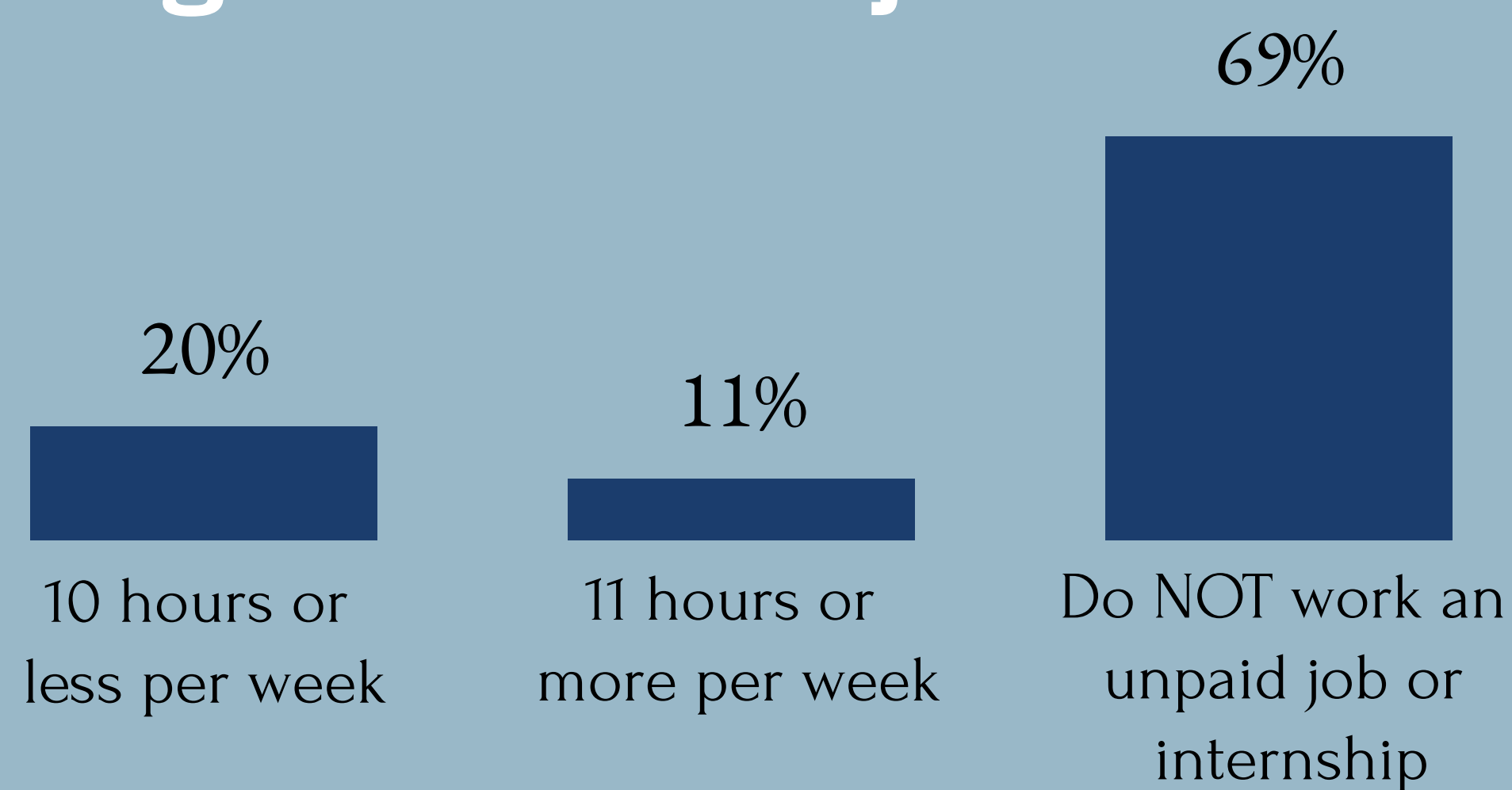

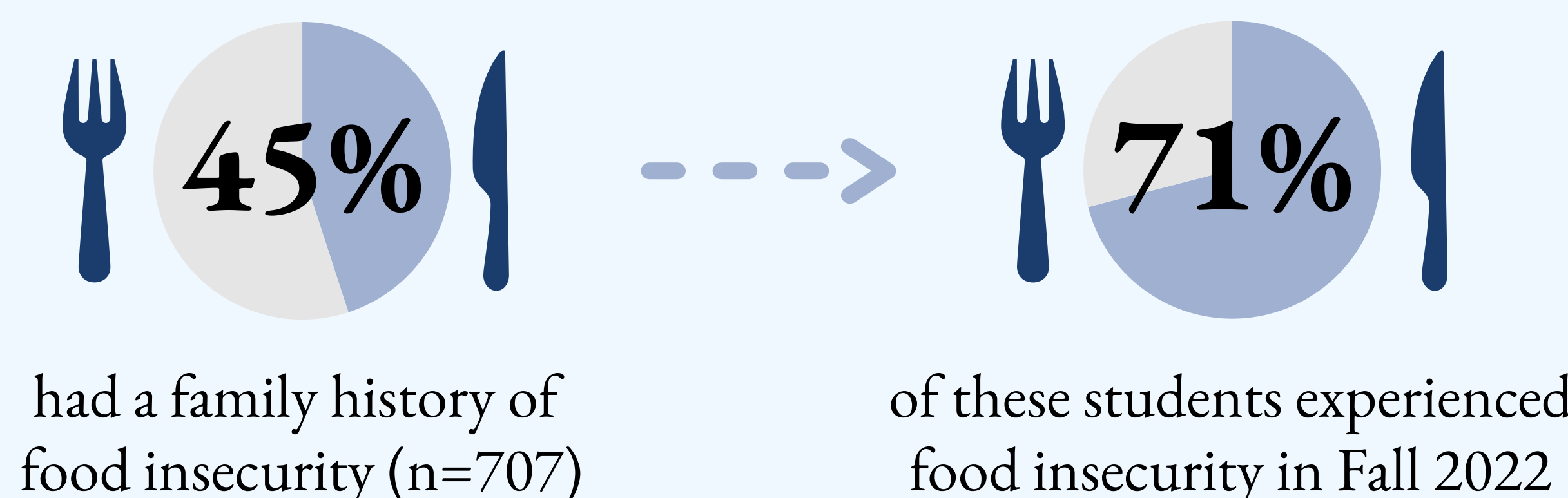
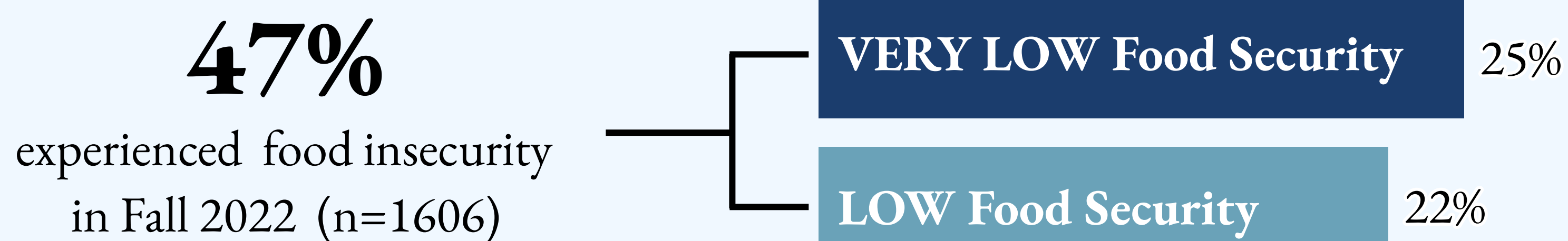
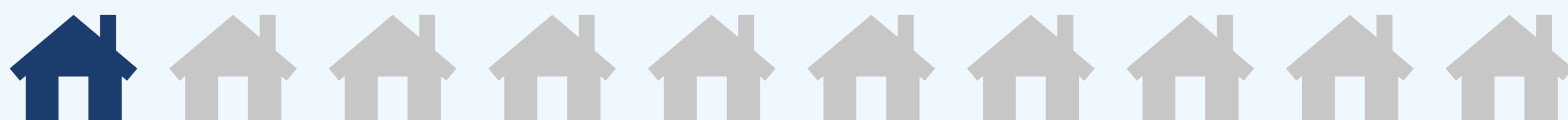
## Working an UNPAID job or internship\* (n=1517)

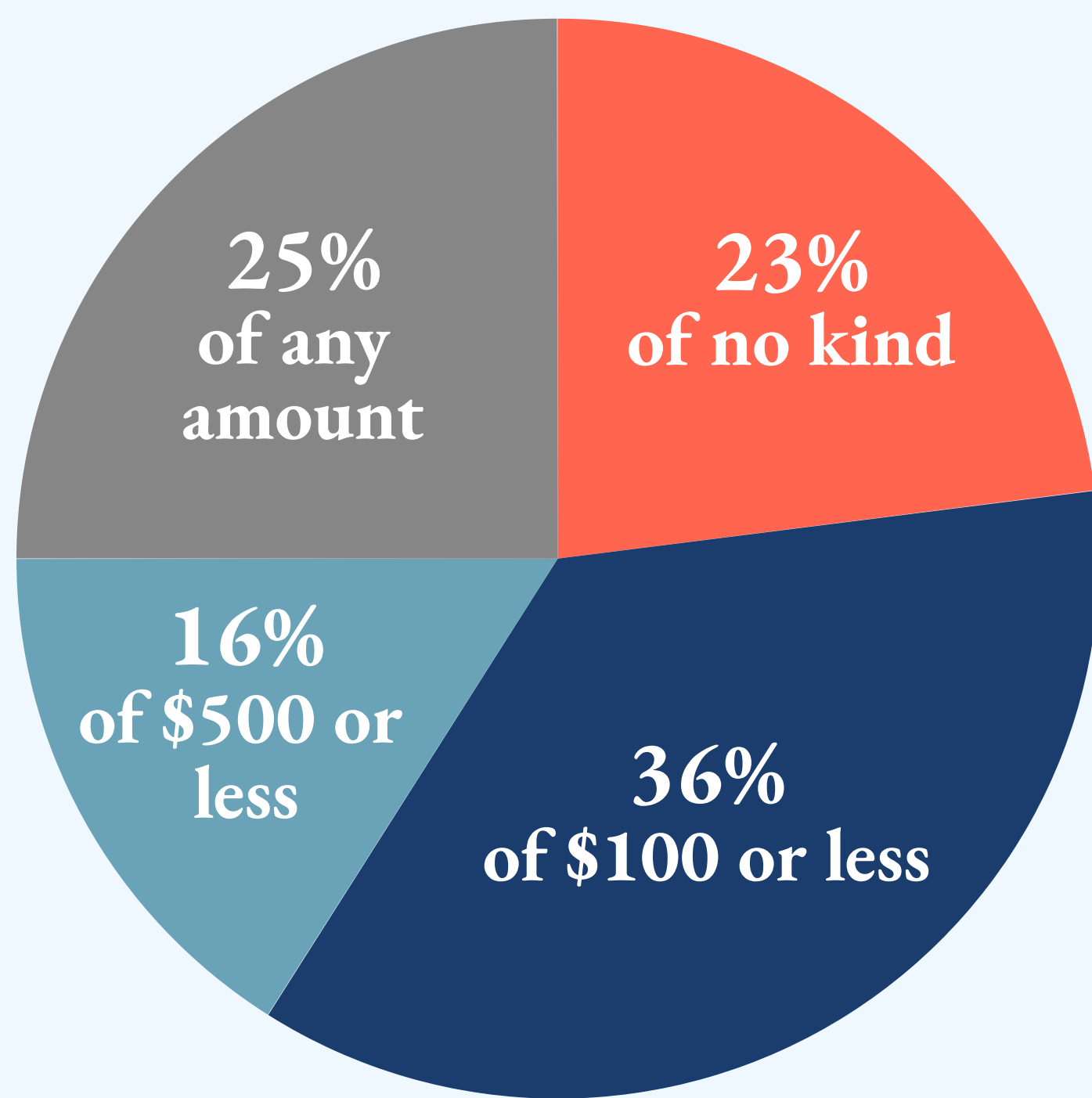


## In Fall 2022, about 1 in 10 students (12%) lacked a safe, regular, and adequate nighttime place to stay and sleep. (n=1578)



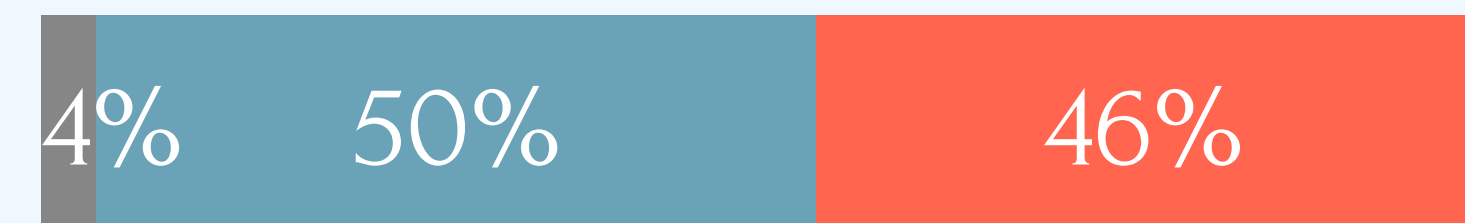


**Currently, I could handle an unexpected emergency expense (Fall 2022)... (n=1598)**

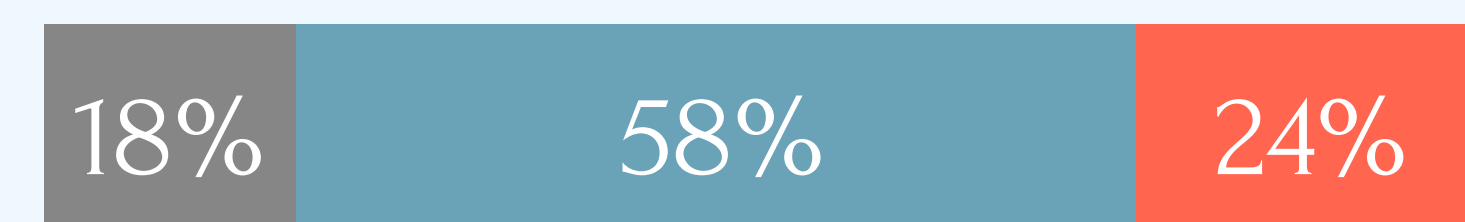


**During Fall 2022...**

Felt stressed about personal finances (n=1601)

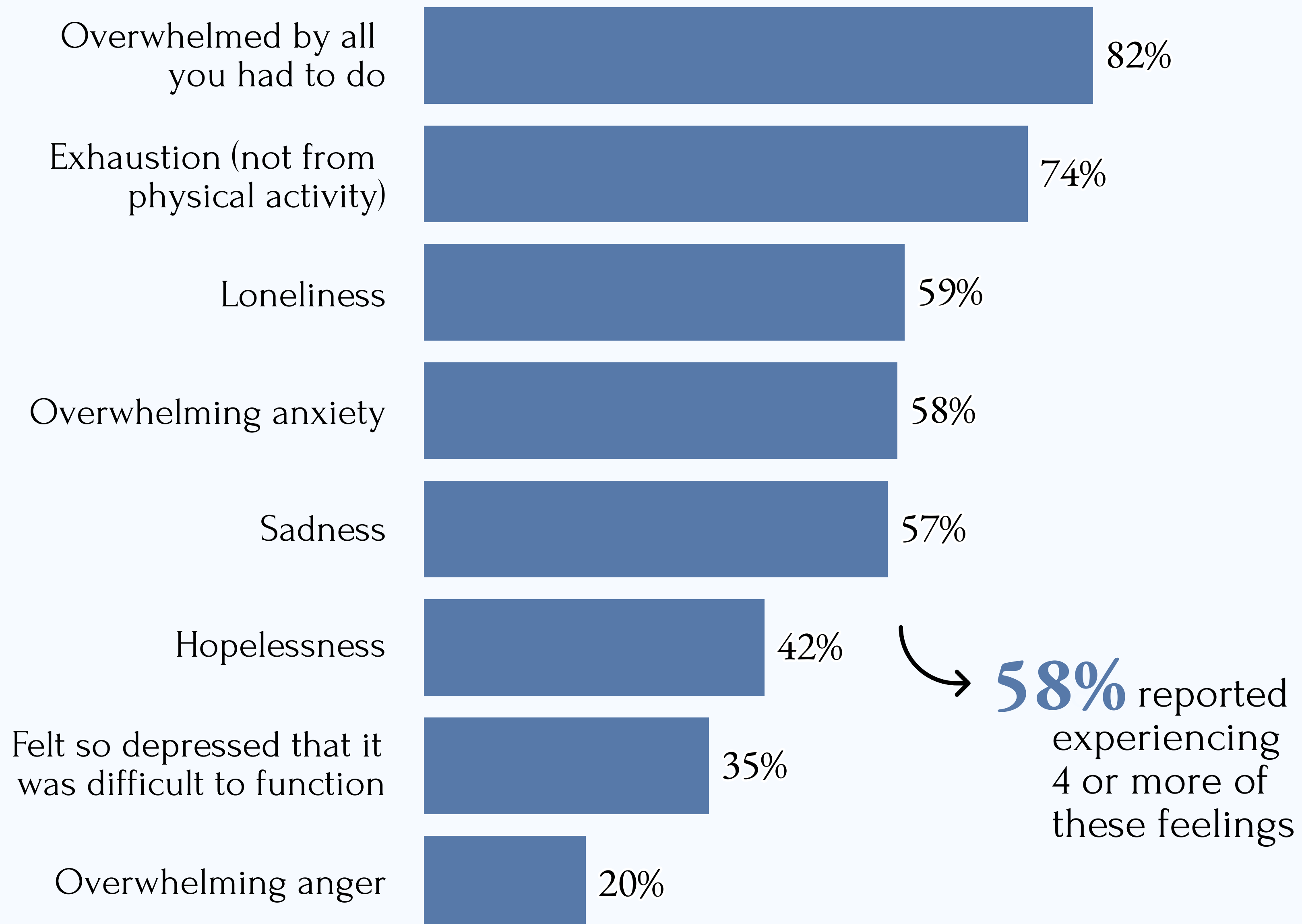


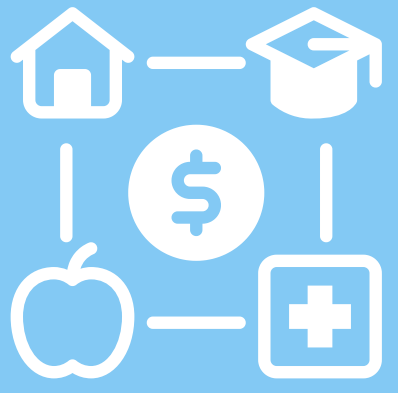

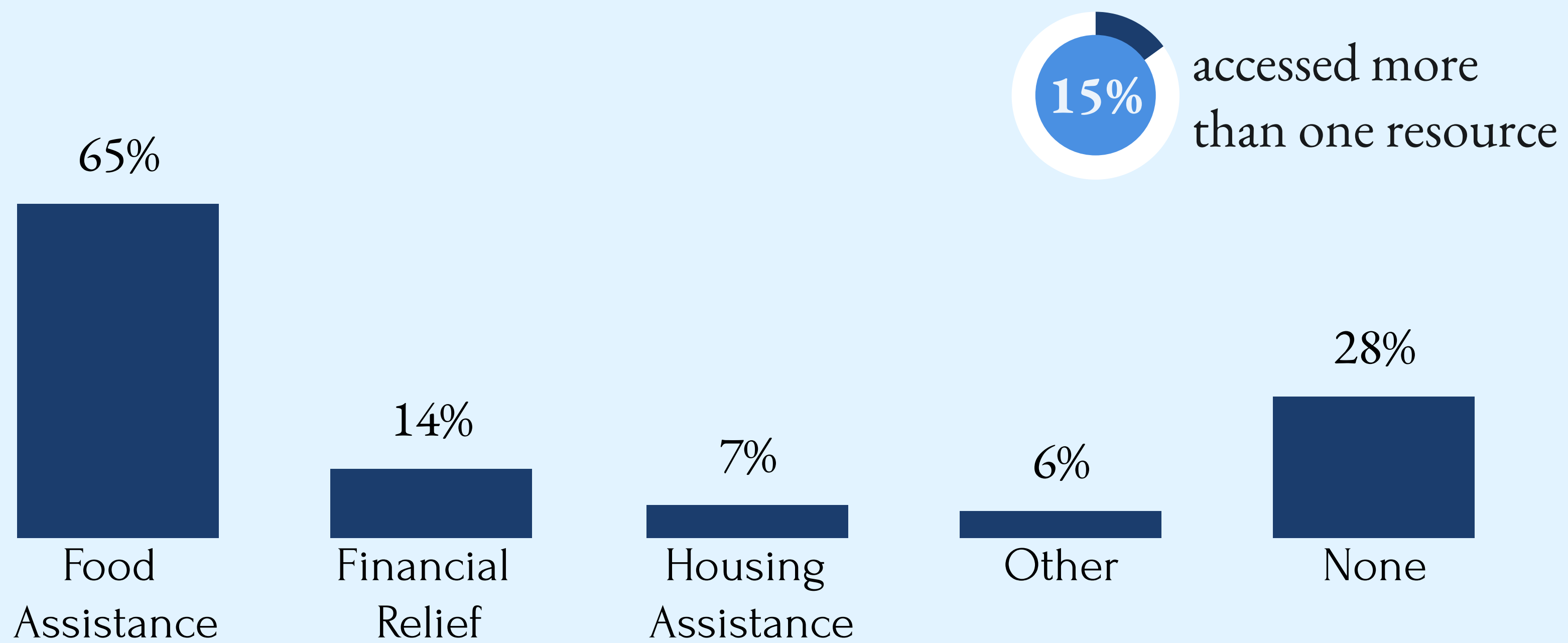

**During Fall 2022, did you experience any of the following feelings? (n=1481)**

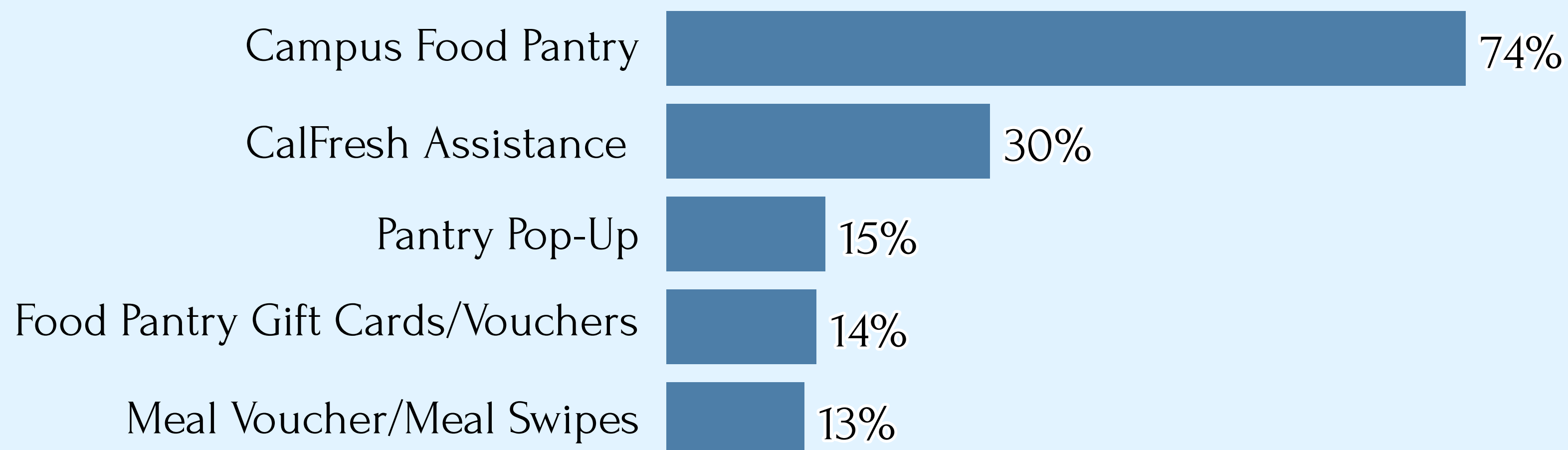




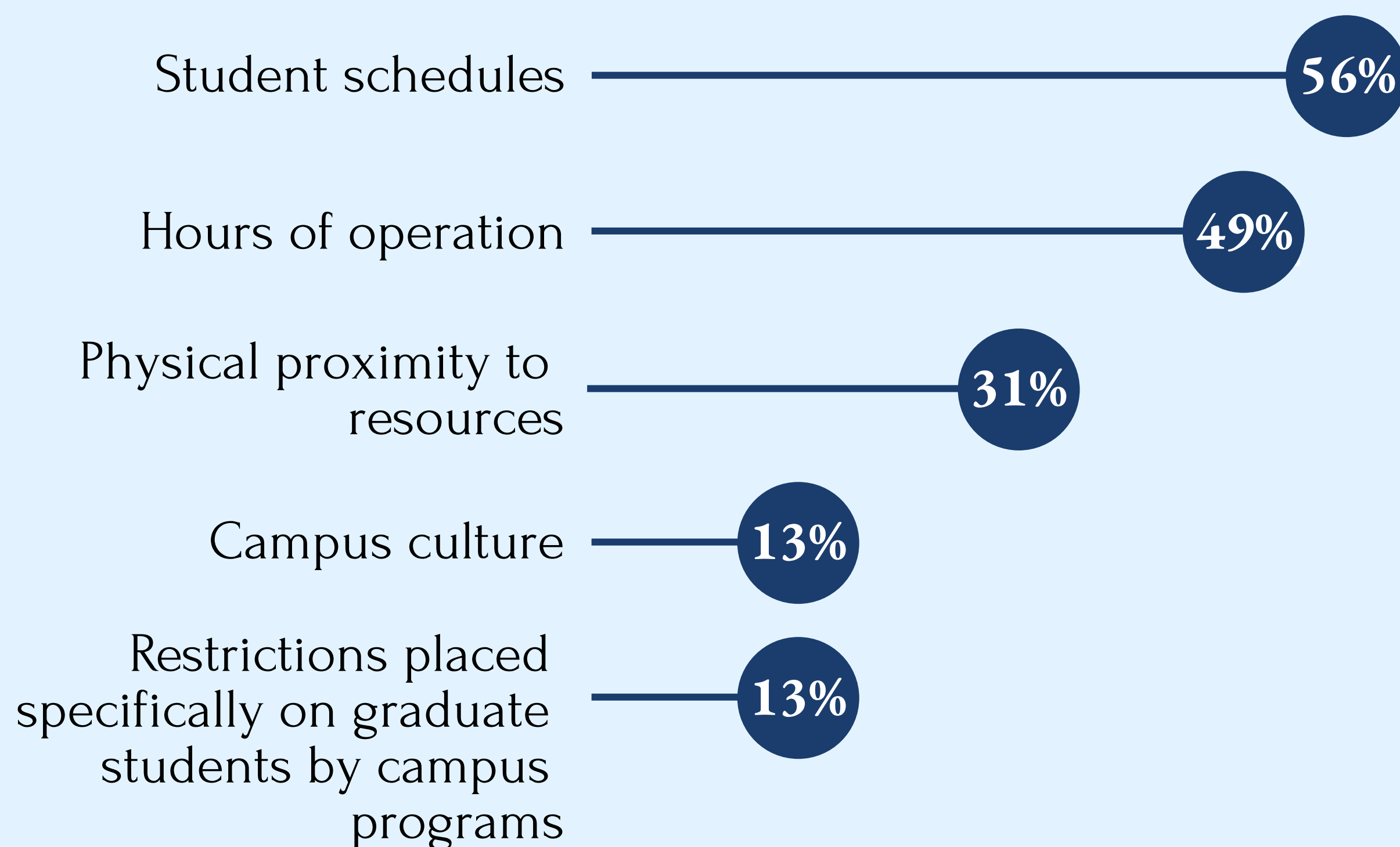
## Did you access any of the following BN resources at your campus, during Fall 2022? (n=1580)



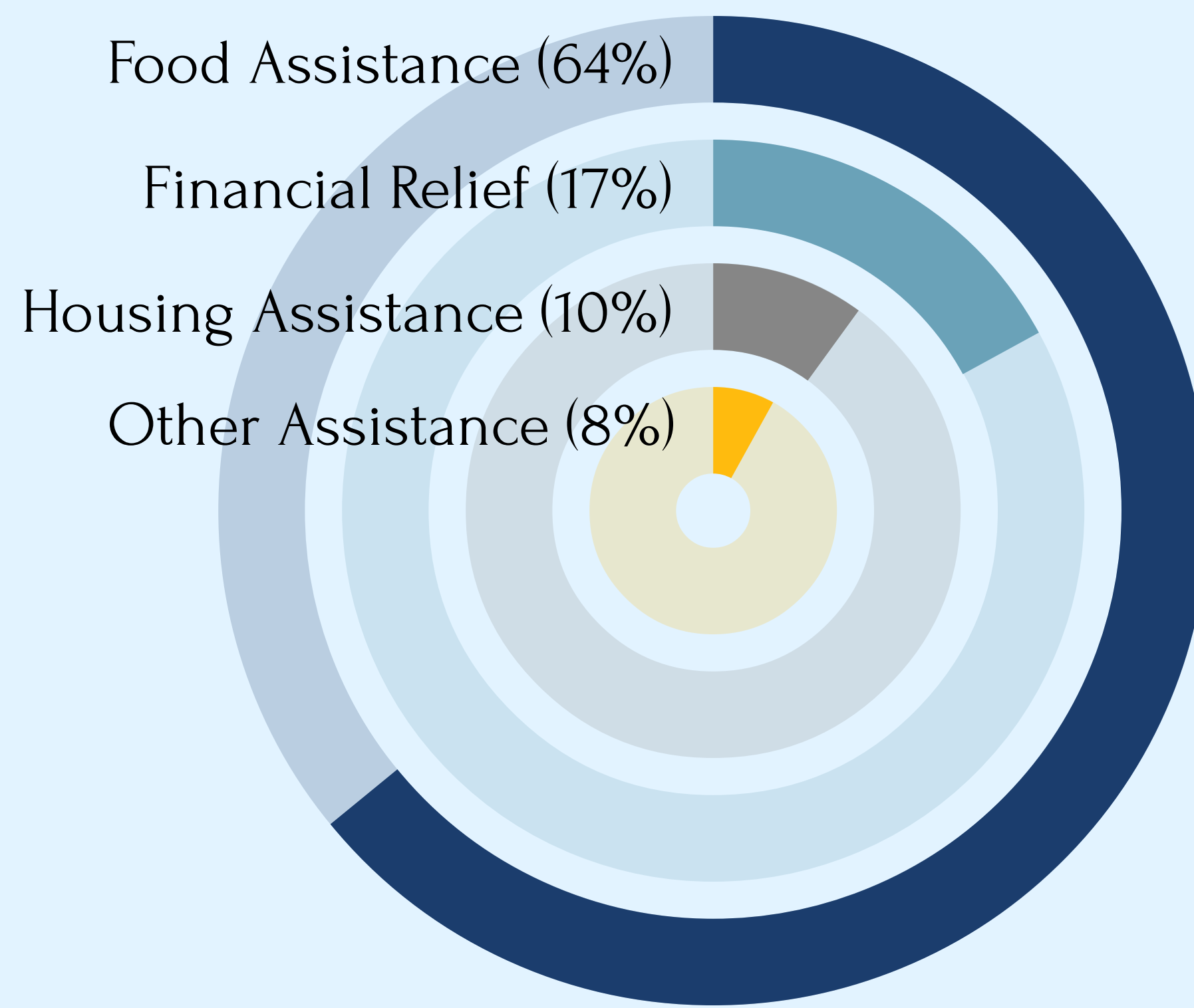
### Top most accessed Food Assistance resources (n=1010)



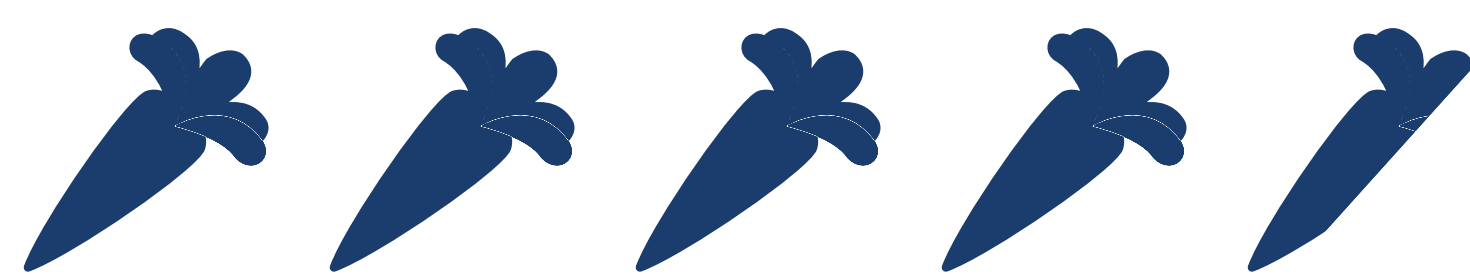
### Barriers to accessing BN resources on campus (n=1555)

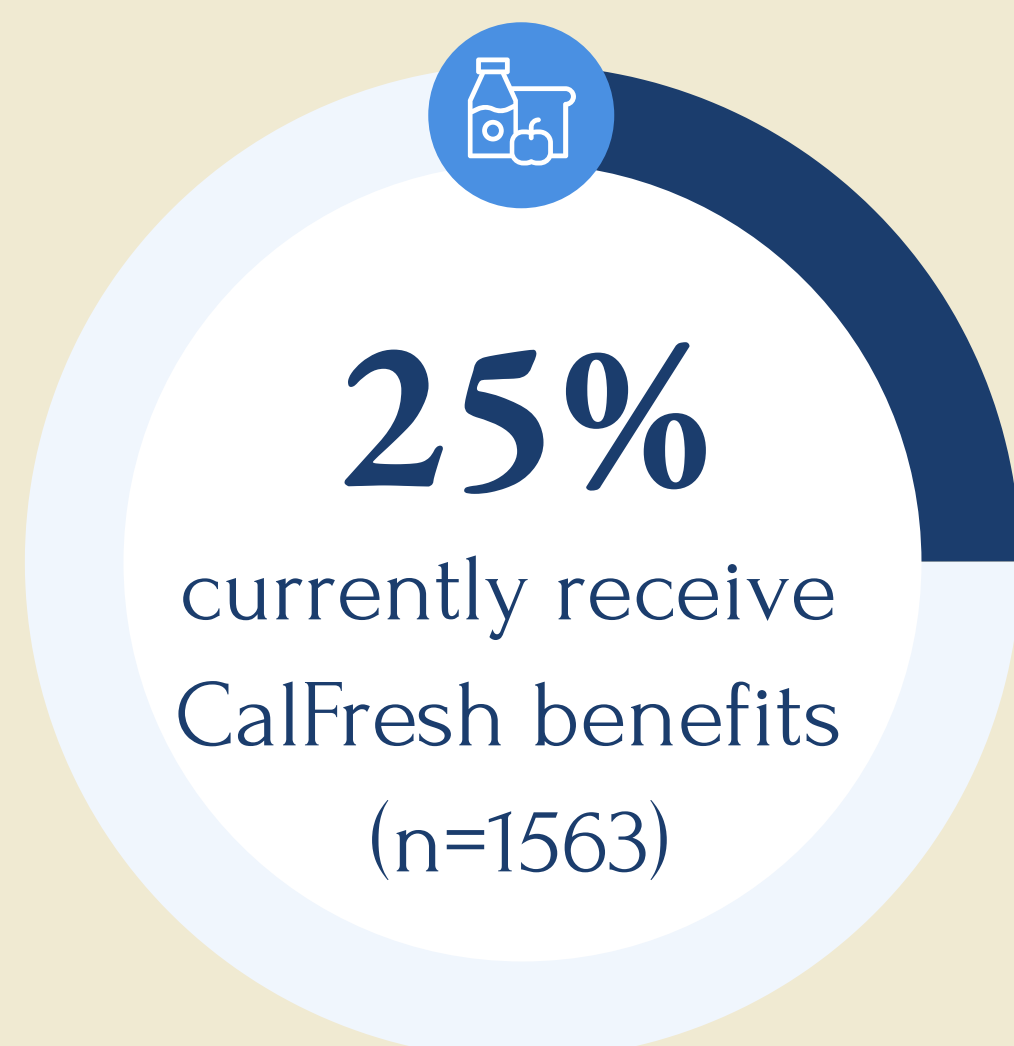


**To what extent does your campus food pantry meet your dietary needs? (n=1539)**
